THE PREVIOUS CALL FOR APPLICATIONS No. 26/00385 OF 9 JULY 2026
FOR THE SELECTION OF THIRTY (30) SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS TO PURSUE A
SPECIALISED MASTER'S IN AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE AND RECYCLING (CAMRA)

As part of its mission to support the sustainable development of the air transport industry, the Central African Air Navigation Safety Agency (ASSA-AC), in partnership with the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority Training School (EFO-CCAA), the European Vallair Group, and the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaoundé (NASEY) of the University of Yaoundé I, is organising a competitive examination to award scholarships for admission to the fourth batch of the Specialised Master's in Aircraft Maintenance and Recycling (CAMRA), offered at EFO-CCAA.

This training programme, open to nationals of the member states of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa (CEMAC), aims to address the shortage of qualified technical staff within its member states in the short and medium term, both in the fields of safety oversight and in the industry.

Graduates of this high-level technical and practical training programme, which lasts twelve (12) months, will be qualified to take up managerial positions in organisations with the following profiles:

- Aircraft Maintenance Organisations;
- Aircraft Dismantling Organisations;
- Continuing Airworthiness Management Organisations, operating independently or within an airline;
- Civil Aviation Administrations (Civil Aviation Authorities, Ministries, Accident Investigation Offices, etc.);
- Any other related activities.

The CAMRA training programme is facilitated by experts from the aviation industry (pilots, aeronautical engineers, air traffic controllers), lecturers from the National Advanced School

of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY), and other academics in the fields of maintenance and production.

Classes will begin in **October 2026** and will run for twelve (12) months at the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority Training School (EFO-CCAA), located at the entrance of Yaounde Nsimalen International Airport, and in the premises of the National Advanced School of Engineering of Yaounde (NASEY).

During their training, trainees will undertake a professional internship with an aviation-sector company in the CEMAC region.

a) REQUIRED PROFILE

- Be a holder of an Engineering Degree (master's degree level) / Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Engineering/ Master of Engineering (M.Eng.) in the following fields: mechanical engineering, electricity, electrotechnology, industrial engineering, electromechanical engineering, telecommunications, or any other equivalent degree; or
- Be a holder of a Bachelor of Engineering degree with at least two **(02) years of professional experience** in the aforementioned fields; or
- Be a holder of an Aircraft Maintenance License (Category B1 or B2) with at least **five (05) years of experience** in the aforementioned fields (attach a copy of the AMT booklet demonstrating your professional experience and approved by ANAC);

and

- Have a good command of French and/or English;
- Be **at most 35 years old as at 31 December 2026**.

b) SELECTION PROCEDURE

- **First stage:** Submission of applications as indicated in point (c);
- **Second stage:** Publication of the list of candidates admitted to sit for the examination following review of their applications;
- **Third stage:** Psychometric tests;
- **Fourth stage:** Interviews in English and/or French for shortlisted candidates following stage 3;
- **Fifth stage:** Publication of the final list of admitted candidates.

The registration form is available at <https://efo-ccaa.com/camra-2/> It must be duly completed and signed, and submitted together with all the documents listed below, in accordance with the instructions set out in point (d):

- A cover letter addressed to the Director of the Cameroon Civil Aviation Authority Training School (EFO – CCAA);
- A curriculum vitae;
- A certified copy of the birth certificate;
- A copy of a valid identification document (passport or national identity card);
- A medical certificate issued within the last three (3) months;
- A copy of the required degree or the Aircraft Maintenance Technician License (AMT);



- An extract from the criminal record (Bulletin No. 3) issued within the last three (03) months or an equivalent document;
- Two colour 4pasport size photographs on a white background;
- Proof of payment of the application processing fee of twenty-five thousand (25,000) CFA francs in one of the accounts below:

The applications submission deadline is 13 September 2026.

NB: Incomplete, non-compliant, or late applications will not be considered.

d) PUBLICATION OF THE LIST OF CANDIDATES ADMITTED TO SIT FOR THE EXAMINATION

The list of candidates admitted to sit for the examination will be published no later than **18 September 2026**.

e) DATE AND VENUE OF COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION

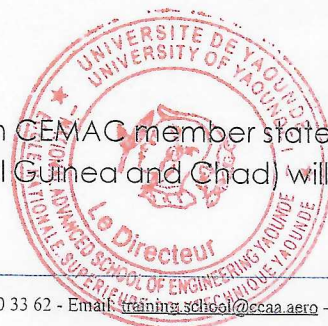
The psychometric tests and selection interviews for candidates will be conducted in accordance with the schedule below in each of the six (06) CEMAC Member States.

The five (05) best candidates finally admitted from each CEMAC member state (Cameroon, the Central African Republic, Congo, Gabon, Equatorial Guinea and Chad) will receive from



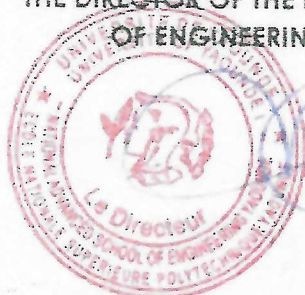
ASSA-AC a scholarship covering tuition fees, a travel voucher from their country of origin to EFO-CCAA, and a monthly stipend for the duration of the training.

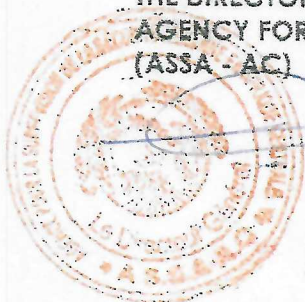
