

DECISION N° 0 0 3 5 4 /D/CCAA/DG/DTAR/SDETA/SATA/Balma of ^{BMA} 31 JUL 2009
Granting an Operating Authorization to Avient Aviation

THE DIRECTOR GENERAL

- Following the Constitution;
- Following the December 1944 convention relative to international Civil Aviation signed at Chicago;
- Following law N° 98/023 of 24th December 1998 bearing the civil Aviation system;
- Following decree N° 99/198 of 16th September 1999 bearing the civil aviation authority's organisation and functioning;
- Following the agreement relative to air transport revised on the 4th of June 2009 in Yaounde between the Republic of Cameroon and the Republic of Zimbabwe.
- Following the decision relative to the Yamoussoukro declarations concerning the liberalisation of access to air transport markets in Africa;
- Following the notification of 10th of June 2009 from the Zimbabwean Civil Aviation Authority, on the designation of Avient Aviation;

DECIDES:

ARTICLE 1: In accordance with the provisions of article 2 of the bilateral air services agreement between the Republic of Cameroon and the Republic of Zimbabwe, the company **Avient Aviation** is authorized to operate air services between the Republic of Cameroon and the Republic of Zimbabwe.

ARTICLE 2: In the operation of approved air services, the present Authorization does not exempt the observation of pertinent bilateral agreement dispositions between the Republic of Cameroon and the Republic of Zimbabwe, revised on the 4th of June 2009 in Yaounde.


Article 3: The CCAA reserves the right, to suspend or withdraw this Authorization if six months after issuance, the air services conceded for operations has not taken effect.
